### Conditions / Warnings



WADA has defined washout periods for out-of-competition use of glucocorticoids. These washout periods are dependent on the type and route of glucocorticoid administered, and they determine when a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) may be necessary. The intravenous (IV) infusion and/or injection of more than 100mL per 12 hour period of any substance is a prohibited method, even if the substance itself is not prohibited, unless it is received while being treated at the hospital, during surgery, or during clinical diagnostic investigations.
